Minutes of a meeting of the Planning Applications Sub-Committee held at the Sports Pavilion, Barcombe on Tuesday 2nd December 2008 at 7.00 p.m.

948. Present: Councillors N C Lear, A J MacGillivray, D J Lloyd, N Gant, D Skan, R Williams and J O Cornwell

949. Apologies for absence: Received from Cllrs C M Arbenz, R Hepple and J C Cornwell.

950. Declarations of interest: Cllr J Cornwell, Cllr N Gant (both owners of neighbouring property) and Cllr D Skan (Chairman of the Village Hall Committee)

951. Urgent business pursuant to Standing Order No. 16: There was none

952. New village hall: The purpose of the meeting was to sign off the planning application. It was explained that this was not ready as discussions were still going on with the planning officer, Mr Andrew Hill. Drawings were tabled and Mr Don Hall of CNP Management, project managers, attended to expound them. It was reported that these drawings were likely to meet with approval from Mr Hill and if so the planning application should be ready very soon. Mr Hall said there were no material differences from the November version except that there was now to be a separate pedestrian access and some of the parking was to be near the road. The green roof was discussed and questions raised as to its longevity. It was resolved that Cllrs Nick Lear and Alex MacGillivray be authorised to approve the application when it was ready subject to there being no material differences.
