Minutes of the Planning Applications Sub-Committee meeting held at the Sports Pavilion, Barcombe on Thursday 6th May 2010 at 7.00 p.m.

1686. Present: Cllrs A J MacGillivray, D J Lloyd (who took the chair), N C Lear, R Williams, D Skan and J O Cornwell; and Cllr A Pearce

1687. Apologies for absence: Received from Cllr C M Arbenz

1688. Declarations of Interest: Cllr A J MacGillivray declared an interest in LW/10/0320

1689. Urgent Business pursuant to Standing Order No. 16: There was none.

1690. Planning applications received:

LW/10/0320 – Barcombe Cross House, School Hill – erection of conservatory and porch to east elevation, enlarged attic rooms along the central valley and Section 73A Retrospective application for the retention of carport for camper van adjacent to School Hill boundary fence for Mr J Gray – Cllr A J MacGillivray left the meeting while this issue was discussed. The parish council agreed to i) reaffirm the comments made in respect of the previous application reference LW/09/1288 ii) object to the conservatory as no information was given about design, materials etc for a structure in the Conservation Area iii) object to the car port as proposed given the external appearance from School Hill

LW/10/0460 1 Grange Road, Barcombe – proposed alterations and one/two storey side/rear extensions for Mrs C Wade – no objections

LW/10/0471 – The Anglers Rest, Barcombe Mills Road – erection of a first floor rear extension and entrance porch for Mr & Mrs King – it was agreed to object because it was felt the extension appeared too big in relation to the size of the original building, the roof design was not in keeping and the proposed glazed area was too large.
