

## BARCOMBE PARISH COUNCIL

### **Minutes of a meeting of the Planning Applications Sub-Committee held at the Sports Pavilion, Barcombe on Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> December 2007 at 7.50 pm**

**402. Present:** Councillors C. Arbenz (Chairman), A.J. MacGillivray, D J Lloyd, D Skan, J O Cornwell and R Williams. Also in attendance were Cllrs N Gant, J C Cornwell and R Hepple.

**403. Apologies for absence:** Received from Cllr N C Lear

**404. Declarations of interest:** None were declared

**405. Urgent Business pursuant to Standing Order No. 16:** Cllr MacGillivray reported on a conversation with a resident of Barcombe Mills purporting to represent the Barcombe mills Society. She expressed concern over the planning application for the Royal Oak's sign in the car park and was unaware it had been in situ for two years and this application was merely regularising the situation. The role and aims of the newly revived Society are unclear but it is hoped that a positive dialogue and liaison with the Parish Council can be developed.

**406. Planning applications received:** LW/07/1406 – Deans Warehouse, Deans Meadow – temporary change of use of office/garage to living accommodation for Mr M. Cooper – no objections

**407. Local authority application (Reg 3)** – extension of existing car park in Mongers Mead to provide additional six spaces including disabled parking for Lewes District Council. Cllr Williams reported on a very positive neighbourhood consultation. Residents hoped the “residents and visitors only” parking sign would be retained and that a new tree would be planted. The Parish Council is grateful that Lewes DC has adopted its proposals to improve the parking
